Please make sure to label your camper's clothing & equipment.

Camp Dress Code

All clothing and swimwear are to be modest and appropriate to an Orthodox Christian witness. Clothing cannot promote violence, alcohol, tobacco and drug use or display undesirable messages. Please NO short shorts. Shorts should be knee length or just a couple of inches above. NO undergarments should be visible. Pants should be worn at the waist without saggin' or baggin'. Pajamas should be worn only at night in the cabin. Please, modest swimwear only.

Church Services

Every day at camp we serve matins in the morning and vespers in the evening. On the last day we will serve Divine Liturgy.

It is given that children will be in church in their camp clothing. This is ok and a normal occurrence at Orthodox summer camps due to timing of daily activities.

However, it would be good to dress more appropriately, skirt/dress for girls and pants for boys, for the Divine Liturgy on the last day of camp.

Clothing (See dress code above)

- Socks/underwear one pair a day
- T-shirts (your child will receive a camp t-shirt as well)
- O Shorts
- Jeans/Khakis/Skirt (There will be daily matins and vespers and Divine Liturgy on the last day).
- Swimsuits: BOYS trunks. GIRLS – one piece only.
- Waterproof jacket/Sweater or Sweatshirt.
- Shoes: All children will need a pair of sneakers to participate in any sports/camp-wide activities.
 - Water shoes/waterproof sandals for the beach to protect from seashell and barnacle cuts.
- Please ensure that your kids are prepared for **Rain or Shine.**

Basic Gear

- Water Bottle ESSENTIAL!
- Sunscreen we have a limited supply only.
- Sleeping bag or sheet & blanket.
- O Pillow
- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Bath/Beach Towel
- Comb/Brush
- Soap/Shampoo
- Laundry bag
- Flashlight
- Insect repellent

Other

- O Sun hat
- O Bible
- Notebook and Pen
- Swimming goggles
- Book instead of electronics.

Medications

- Pack only what you need while at camp.
- Check in all meds with the nurse upon registration

THINGS TO LEAVE AT HOME

- Tobacco/Marijuana Products
- Alcohol & Drugs
- Weapons including pocket knives, etc.
- \circ Food unless this has been preapproved by the nurse
- Electronics of any kind, including smart phones, ipads/ipods, personal gaming devices, etc. THERE IS NO TIME AT CAMP FOR TEXTING/VIDEO GAMING/ETC. DOWN TIME CAN BE SPENT READING, RELAXING, OR HANGING OUT WITH FRIENDS.
- Inappropriate clothing, Valuables, Cash.
